

HOBURNE 5 – TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. The Hoburne 5 Road Race is organised by volunteers of Christchurch Runners and is a non-profit making event with all monies going to local charities.
2. Registration will open at 09:30 on the day of the event and Runners are be required to attend registration to collect their Bib numbers.
3. Runners MUST observe the Highway Code at all times, and in particular, they MUST NOT impede other road users, such as pedestrians, motorists etc.
4. Runners MUST obey the Marshals' Instructions at all times, particularly when crossing the Roads. Runners who ignore the Marshal's Instructions WILL BE DISQUALIFIED.
5. Runners MUST NOT use iPods, musical devices or telephones while participating in the event. Runners wearing earphones or headsets or similar, whether wired, wireless or Bluetooth while participating WILL BE DISQUALIFIED.
6. Runners are responsible for ensuring that their state of health is suitable to compete in this event and should seek medical advice if necessary. Participation will be at the participant's own risk.
7. Runners MUST NOT drop litter around the course. Waste should be placed in suitable bins or brought to the finish.
8. By taking part, all participants, volunteers and spectators confirm that they are happy that their image may be included in any photos or video footage that may be used to publicise the event.
9. The Organisers reserve the right to disqualify, on the grounds of putting on a safe competition for all, any competitors who appear unwell, seriously injured or who are intoxicated.
10. Any Runner withdrawing from the event at any time after Registration MUST notify the Organisers or the nearest Marshal.
11. The Organisers reserve the right to amend, postpone or cancel the event due to unforeseen circumstances. We shall inform you if we intend to re-schedule and if you will be able to transfer your entry fee to a rescheduled event.
12. We will keep your details safe and use them for the sole purpose of administering this event. We will never sell or share them with anyone. Please refer to our [data privacy policy](#) for full details
